The Bachelor of Arts degree requires a minimum of 120 units of which 42 must be upper-division units. (Upper-division courses are numbered 300-499). The Theatre major requires a minimum of 52 units of which at least 18 must be upper-division units. No more than 64 units total may be transferred from two-year college(s).

Registration in most Theatre (TAR) courses is controlled by the School of Theatre, Film and Television. Registration instructions are available at the school's website (tftv.arizona.edu), in the Theatre office, and from Theatre advisors and instructors.
